- Sandi Wong, Dean of the College/Faculty called the meeting to order. She began by announcing
 that President Tiefenthaler would not be joining the meeting as she was attending the funeral
 services for a current student who recently died.

 - Jermyn presented the new power point on the website. During the presentation he showed the committee members various slides examples, so they could here the voiceover.
 - Jermyn commented that he would like to work with Jane and her team to figure out a way to have this presented without it being so problematic/troublesome to have sound working.

 - Some of the main highlights have been:

 - Identifying what we do well and improving on those.
 - It should be noted that the academic divisional meetings were not "informational" as the faculty have heard the information regarding the process several times. It was said that the President approved these sessions as being more input gathering, unlike what was originally intended.
